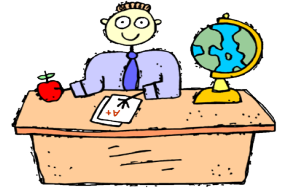
There are five kinds of senses in humans : hearing, touch, sight, taste and smell. The senses exist and function in relation to the objective world.

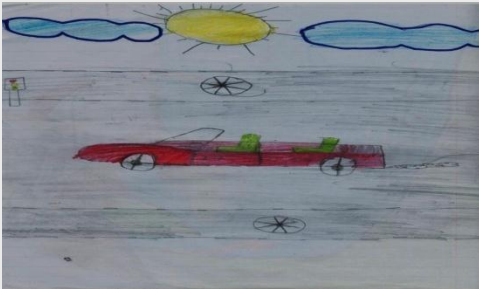
## WORLD ENVIROMENT DAY
